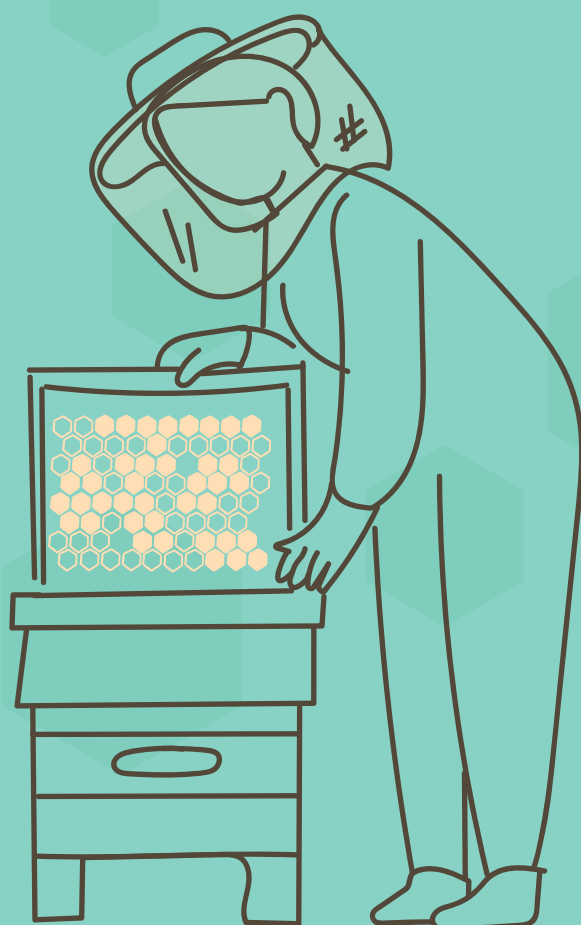

Good Cleaning and Hygiene Practices

Do not use broodcombs in honey super

To prevent contamination of the honey produced, old brood frames should not be used in the honey supers. Old brood frames may contain residues of medications used for *Varroa* control. They can also darken light-coloured honey and impart an undesirable flavour to the honey.

When you add supers for honey production to your honey bee colony, make sure the frames with wax are of good quality.

The frames should be from fresh drawn combs or wax foundations.

The honey super should **NOT** contain old brood frames.

These frames may contain residues of *Varroa*-control medications. They can also darken light-coloured honey and impart an undesirable flavour.
